RULES OF ASSOCIATION

CLAUSE (5) MEMBERSHIP

- (1) A person who is nominated and approved for membership as provided in these rules is eligible to be a member of the Association on payment of the annual subscription (if any) fixed under these rules.
- (2) A person who is not a member of the Association at the time of the incorporation of the Association is not to be admitted to membership unless:-
 - (a) he has applied as provided in sub-rule (3) of this rule; and
 - (b) his admission as a member is approved by the committee.
- (3) An application of a person for membership of the Association:-
 - (a) shall be made in writing and signed by the applicant; and
 - (b) shall be lodged with the Public Officer of the Association.
- (4) As soon as is practicable after the receipt of an application the Public Officer shall refer the nomination to the committee who shall determine whether to accept or reject the application. An application may only be rejected if:-
 - (a) there are reasonable grounds to believe that the applicant would not abide by the rules and objectives of the association; or
 - (b) required by law; or
 - (c) the applicant has been convicted of an indictable offence; or
 - (d) there are reasonable grounds to believe that the applicant would not abide by the Community Broadcasting Code of Practice; or
 - (e) there are reasonable grounds to believe that the applicant would pose a security risk to the members, property or premises of the Association.
- (5) Upon application being:-
 - (a) approved by the committee; or
 - (b) upon the resolution of the committee to reject an application being overturned on reply or appeal

the Public Officer shall, with as little delay as possible, notify the applicant in writing, that he has been approved for membership of the Association and, upon receipt of the sum payable by or on behalf of the applicant as his first year's subscription, shall enter the applicant's name in a register of members to be kept by the Public Officer, whereupon the applicant becomes a member of the Association.
- (6) Where an application is rejected by the committee, the Public Officer of the Association shall, without undue delay, cause to be served on the applicant a notice in writing:-
 - (a) setting out the decision of the committee and the grounds on which it is based;
 - (b) stating that the applicant shall have rights of reply appeal to the general members of the Association under rule 29.
